- 1. The site is within the Metropolitan Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. The need for the proposed storage development has not been proven, nor have any very special circumstances been submitted to justify an exception to the presumption against the type of development now proposed.
- 2. The proposed building would be visually prominent and would significantly detract from the character and appearance of this area of open countryside. As such the proposed development would conflict with policies contained in the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
