REASONS FOR REFUSAL

1. The site is within the Metropolitan Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum District Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. No such need has been proven and the proposed development is unacceptable in the terms of this policy.

2. Extensions to dwellings within the Green Belt are controlled under Policy 20 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan Deposit Draft. The proposed extension is not acceptable in terms of this policy by reason of its size, bulk, scale and design which would have an adverse effect on the character and appearance of the area. In addition, the extension fails to meet Criterion (E) of this policy, as it amounts to the creation of a separate dwelling on the site contrary to the established tenets of Green Belt policy.
