At their meeting on 25th January, 1978 the Development Control Committee passed the "second resolution" under Article 4(5) of the Town and Country Planning General Regulations to retain this development and so "claimed deemed permission" for the proposal, the subject of the application made on behalf of the Leisure Committee and received on 15th December, 1978. This constitutes formal notification of that decision.

As you are aware conditions are not imposed on "deemed permissions" but the Committee expressed the view that their decision related to a period of 12 months, i.e. until 31st December, 1979, by which time it was hoped that a solution would have been found to enable the activities of the Youth Centre to continue on a more satisfactory permanent basis.
