1. The works for which this consent is granted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this consent.

Reason: To comply with section 18 of the Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2. No works relating to Units 10, 11, 14, 15 and 16 shall be started until drawings of the replacement doors and door cases to these Units at a scale of at least 1:20 shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority. The works shall be carried out prior to occupation of any of the units fully in accordance with the approved details.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the listed building.

3. No works shall take place until full details of the proposed fire proofing measures and noise attenuation measures in respect of all the Units shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority. The works shall be carried out prior to occupation of any of the units fully in accordance with the approved details.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the listed building.

4. No works shall be started on Units 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 until drawings of all new windows to these Units at a scale of at least 1:20 shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority. The works shall be carried out fully in accordance with the approved details prior to the occupation of the development, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the local planning authority.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the listed building.

5. All new windows shall be single glazed with clear glass, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the listed building.

6. The works hereby authorised shall be carried out fully in accordance with the approved plans, including the retention of the existing windows.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the listed building.

7. No moulded architraves, cornices or skirtings shall be removed without the prior written consent of the local planning authority.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the listed building.

8. The works hereby authorised shall only be carried out in accordance with Drawing Nos 1499/2A and 1499/7B submitted with the applicant's letter dated 3 January 1998 and received by the local planning authority on 12 January 1998.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure that the details of the development are acceptable to the local planning authority.
