in accordance with detailed plans and drawings showing the siting, design,
landscaping and external appearance of the building(s) and means of access
thereto which shall have been approved by the local planning authority or
in default of agreement by the Secretary of State.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Article 5 (2) of the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977-85.

- 2. Application for approval in respect of all matters reserved in condition 1 above shall be made to the local planning authority within a period of three years commencing on the date of this notice and the development to which this permission relates shall be begun not later than whichever is the later of the following dates:
 - (i) The expiration of a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.
 - (ii) The expiration of a period of two years commencing on the date upon which final approval is given by the local planning authority or by the Secretary of State or, in the case of approval given on different dates, the final approval by the local planning authority or the Secretary of State.

Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.92 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.


- 3. Details submitted in accordance with condition 1 hereof shall include:-
 - (a) a survey of the site including levels, natural features, trees and hedges;
 - (b) garaging, parking and circulation facilities;
 - (c) refuse collection and general storage arrangements;
 - (d) boundary treatment;
 - (e) construction of drains and sewers.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory development.
