1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The roof of the development hereby permitted shall be constructed using natural slate with rolled lead hips.

Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

3. Any stone used in the construction of the development hereby approved shall be natural stone in accordance with a sample which shall be submitted to and approved by the local planning authority before development is commenced.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

4. No work shall be started on the development hereby permitted until details of the material finish, colour, shape and size of guttering to be used shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority, and the development hereby permitted shall be carried out with the guttering so approved.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

5. No development shall take place within the proposed development site until the applicant has secured the implementation of a programme of archaeological work within a written scheme of investigation which has been submitted by the applicant and approved by the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure that reasonable facilities are made available to record archaeological evidence.

6. The part of the north elevation which is contained within the extension hereby permitted shall not receive any plaster or other finish.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.
