The site is within the Metropolitan Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum District Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. No agricultural need has been proven for the continuation of the residential use at the site as the smallholding is not viable and consequently the proposal is unacceptable in terms of Green Belt policy.
