Only the following work shall be carried out and in accordance with British Stanbdard 3998 (1989) Recommendation for Tree Work.

- Cherry Tree in rear garden of No. 10 Covert Road:
   Fell.
- 2. A replacement tree shall be planted in the first planting season following the removal of the tree. The replacement shall be a standard in size ie, at least 8-10 cm girth at 1 m above ground level and 2.75 to 3 m overall height.
- 3. The replacement tree shall be planted as close as practically possible to the site of the existing tree and shall be the following:

Malus 'Golden Hornet'.

4. The Council must be notified when the replacement has been planted so that an inspection can be carried out.

## **REASONS:**

- 1. The Cherry Tree is dying.
- 2. The replacement tree is of an ornamental species suitable for a residential garden.
