1 The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The entrance gates hereby permitted shall be constructed of timber or such other material as may be agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. The entrance gates hereby permitted shall only open inwards.

Reason: In the interests of highway safety.

4. Within three months from the date of this decision, the entrance gates and all existing front boundary fences shall be stained in a colour which shall first have been agreed in writing by the local planning authority, and the gates and fences shall be maintained in the colour so agreed.

Reason: In the interests of visual amenity.
