1. The Beech tree identified in red on plan No.  $1191/ extsf{L}1 extsf{B}$  only shall be felled.

Reason: The Beech has suffered extensive root damage as a result of creation of the access road.

Two semi-mature trees identified in green on Plan No. 1191/LIB shall be planted in the first planting season following the occupation of the dwellings or the completion of the development whichever is the sooner; and any trees or plants which within a period of 5 years from the completion of the development die, are removed or become seriously damaged or diseased shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of similar size and species, unless the local planning authority gives written consent to any variation, and for the purposes of this condition a planting season shall be deemed to commence in any one year on 1 October and to end on 31 March in the next following year.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

 All works shall be carried out in accordance with BS 5837 Recommendations for Tree Work.
