Brief description  
and location of  
proposed tree work

In pursuance of their powers under the above-mentioned Acts and the Orders and Regulations for the time being in force thereunder the Council hereby permit/~~refuse~~ the tree work proposed by you in your application dated subject to the following conditions:

1 February 1990

1. A replacement tree shall be planted in the first planting season following removal of the existing tree.
2. The replacement shall be a standard in size ie, at least 8-10cm girth at 1m above ground level and to be planted at a suitable location in the vicinity of the existing tree.
3. The replacement shall be one of the following species:-
  - a. Beech (*fagus sylvatica*)
  - b. Small Leafed Lime (*Tilic cordata*)
  - c. Norway Maple (*Acer plantanoidies*)
4. The Council must be notified when the replacement tree has been planted so that an inspection can be carried out.
