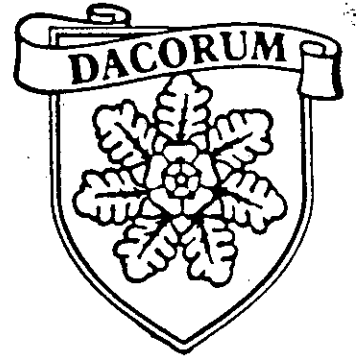

The proposal represents an undesirable form of two tier backland development being served by a long and narrow means of access, which is substandard in width and visibility, passing between two existing dwellings. Such a development would give rise to conditions detrimental to the amenities of adjacent residential properties.
