Landscape Coding/Survey PROPOSED WEEPING WALL SLURRY STORE
RUMBLERS FARM, POTTEN END HILL, POTTEN END
Conditions to be attached to deemed planning permission (4/151-92)

1. LANDSCAPING

The landscaping referred to in the development hereby permitted shall be carried out within the first available planting season after construction of the slurry store, unless this period is extended in writing by the County Planning Authority. Any shrub which dies or is severely damaged within three years of planting shall be replaced during the first available planting season to the satisfaction of the County Planning Authority.

Reason: To ensure adequate and satisfactory landscaping of the development in the interests of the amenity of the area.

2. POLLUTION CONTROL

No solid matter shall be deposited so that it passes or is likely to pass into any watercourse.

Reason: To prevent pollution of the water environment in accordance with the requirement of the National Rivers Authority.
