REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00159/98/FUL

Date of Decision: 25 March 1998

The application site forms part of the curtilage of Piccotts End Farm, a Grade II listed building, and is located within Piccotts End Conservation Area. The proposed new access would result in the loss of a significant section of the boundary wall to Piccotts End Farm. The wall is important both in terms of its contribution to the setting of the listed building and the character of this part of Piccotts End Conservation Area. In addition the works associated with the formation of the driveway would result in the loss of historic features and would alter the form of a historic site relating to the farm complex as a whole. For these reasons the proposals would be detrimental to the setting of the listed farmhouse and would neither preserve nor enhance the character of a designated Conservation Area. The development would therefore be contrary to Policies 109 and 110 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan and national advice contained in Department of the Environment Planning Policy Guidance Note 15.
