## CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00170/97/TPO

Date of Decision: 14 April 1997

All work shall conform to the standards set out in BS 3998 'Recommendations for Tree Work', and shall be limited only to the following:

- A) Lime Trees T1 and T2 adjacent to rear boundary with 'Cherry Trees':
- i) thin crowns by 25% and reduce the low lateral branches over garden by 2 metres to balance crown;
  - ii) remove branches crowding the Silver Birch tree;
- B) Lime Tree T3 situated in Lane End on the side boundary of 'Penshurst':
- i) thin by 25%, reduce the overlong and heavy laterals by 2-3 metres only and remove basal trunk suckers.

<u>Reason</u>: BS 3998 will ensure the correct standard of work to ensure the retention of the amenity value of the trees.
