1. The number of firing positions shall not exceed 5 without the prior written consent of the local planning authority.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of nearby residents.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town and Country (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 or any amendments thereto clay pigeon shooting shall only take place on alternate Sundays.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of nearby residents.

3. No shooting shall occur outside the hours of 10.30 am and 2.30 pm.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of nearby residents.

4. Noise emissions from the clay pigeon shooting activity shall not exceed 65 dB(A)(1) which is the average impulse (1), 'A' weighted maxima of a minimum of 25 measurements taken at the position marked X on Plan Ref: 4/0180/96RD (1:1000 scale). The measurements shall be taken at a height of 1.2 m above ground level except where the site is enclosed by a wall or other sound opaque structure at or near the perimeter when measurements shall be taken at a position high enough to measure noise coming over the top of such a structure.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of nearby residents.

5. If the use hereby permitted ceases to operate all building structures and material shall be removed from the site within 28 days.

 $\frac{Reason}{Planning}$: To safeguard and maintain the strategic policies of the local planning authorities as expressed in the County Structure Plan and Dacorum Borough Local Plan and in the interests of visual amenity.

6. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (or any order revoking and re-enacting that Order with or without modification) there shall be no development falling within Class B, Part 4, Schedule 2 of the Order without the express written permission of the local planning authority.
