1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

 \underline{Reason} : To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. No work shall be started on the development hereby permitted until details of materials to be used externally shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority, and the development hereby permitted shall be carried out in the materials so approved.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. Before development commences full details of any internal or external filtration, ventilation, ducting systems shall be submitted to and approved by the local planning authority.

Reason: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.

4. All windows and door openings shall have Gauged flat brick arches.

Reason: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.

5. All windows shall be white painted timber and of sliding sash construction.

Reason: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.

6. All doors shall be of painted timber construction.

Reason: In the interests of preserving the character and appearance of the building.

7. Before development commences full details of the materials for the flat roof element of the proposal shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority.
