REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00196/97/FUL

- 1. The proposed use would attract a significant amount of vehicular and pedestrian traffic to the site which would, particulary during the evening, cause disturbance to occupants of surrounding dwellings reducing their amenities to a level below that which they would normally expect to enjoy. The proposal would therefore be contrary to the aims of Policies 8 and 42 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
- 2. The air purification system proposed is not adequate. The low discharge point proposed would not allow sufficient dilution of odours. The proposed use would therefore be likely to produce smell nuisance which would significantly detract from the amenities of nearby dwellings and businesses. The proposal would therefore be contrary to the aims of Policies 8 and 42 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
- 3. There is inadequate provision for vehicle parking within the site to meet standards adopted by the local planning authority. The proposed takeaway use is likely to generate a demand for short stay on-street parking; this is likely to exacerbate existing parking problems in the vicinity of the site which would result in consequential inconvenience and danger to road users.
