2. Any advertisements displayed, and any site used for the display of advertisements shall be maintained in a clean and tidy condition to the reasonable satisfaction of the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (Amendments) Regulations 1994.

3. Any structure or hoarding erected or used principally for the purpose of displaying advertisements shall be maintained in a safe condition.
