- 1. Three replacement trees shall be planted in the first planting season following removal of the 3 existing trees. The replacements shall be light standards in size \underline{ie} at least 6-8 cms girth at 1 m above ground level and 2.5 to 2.75 m in overall height.
- The replacements shall be planted as close as practically possible to the site of the existing trees and shall be selected from the following species:
 - (i) Quercus rubra (Red Oak)
 - (ii) Carpinus betulus (Hornbeam)
 - (iii) Liquidambar styraciflua (Sweetgum)
 - (iv) Alnus cordata (Italian Alder)
- 3. The Council must be notified when the replacement trees have been planted so that an inspection can be carried out.

REASONS:

- One tree had already fallen in the gales of 1990.
- The leaning Pine tree appears to have moved at the base and could be a safety hazard.
- 3. The Oak is in poor condition with major deadwood throughout the crown. The low vigour of the crown indicates root decay and felling is advisable on safety grounds.
