1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The development hereby permitted shall be constructed in white or cream painted timber or such other materials as may be agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development.

3. No development shall take place until samples of the materials proposed to be used on the external brick plinth of the development have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. The approved materials shall be used in the implementation of the development.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development.

4. This permission only relates to the use of the building and not the rear garden.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt.
