- 1. The site is within a rural area beyond the Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum District Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. No such need has been proven and the proposed development is unacceptable in the terms of this policy.
- The site is within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, wherein the prime planning consideration will be the preservation of the beauty of the area, and also within the Gade river valley, where it is the policy of the local planning authority to seek to safeguard sites of nature conservation value from development pressure. The proposed development is unacceptable in the terms of these policies.
- 3. The proposal would have a detrimental effect on the setting of Water End Conservation Area.
