1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The materials to be used in the construction of the external surfaces of the extension hereby permitted shall match in size, colour and texture those used on the existing building.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building.

3. Notwithstanding the details shown on Drawing number 97101/03, only the rooflight on the west elevation shown on Drawing number 97101/02B is hereby approved.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building.

4. The first floor window in the east elevation shall be permanently blocked up with a fixed timber panel stained black as shown on the approved plan Drawing number 97101/02B.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of the visual amenities of the countryside and the appearance of the listed building itself.

5. All windows and doors shall be clear glazed, and constructed of softwood painted or stained to match the existing windows and doors.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the listed building.

6. The width of all new timber boarding shall match the existing boarding.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building.
