1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The materials used externally shall match both in colour and texture those on the existing building of which this development shall form a part.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. Within one month of the completion of the development hereby permitted, the existing garage shown on Plan Ref. 4/0325/96FH shall be demolished and the materials removed from the site.

Reason: In the interests of amenity and to safeguard and maintain the strategic policies of the local planning authorities as expressed in the County Structure Plan and Dacorum Borough Local Plan.

4. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order 1995 (or any Order revoking and re-enacting that Order) (with or without modification), there shall be no development falling within Class E, Part 1, Schedule 2 of the Order without the prior written permission of the Local Planning Authority.
