REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00371/97/TPO

These three trees have grown as one and represent one crown. The removal of the centre tree would open up the remaining trees to wind as well as being detrimental to the trees' visual amenity. The Sycamore located on the boundary of 38 Glendale has grown with a lean because of the other 2 trees and hence will have grown to cope with this lean. Large branches have been removed in the past from the lower stem causing large wounds and further large branch removal is unnecessary and detrimental to the health of the tree.
