**1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.**

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

**2. No development shall take place until samples of the materials to be used in the construction of the external surfaces of the development hereby permitted have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. Development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.**

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building.

**3. No external ventilation or extraction equipment shall be provided until details shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority.**

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building.

**4. No groundworks shall take place within the area indicated until the applicant, or their agents or successors in title, has secured the implementation of a programme of archaeological work in accordance with the Written Scheme of Investigation prepared by Archaeological Services and Consultancy Ltd received by the local planning authority on 29 April 1999.**

Reason: To ensure that reasonable facilities are made available to record archaeological evidence.
