 The works to which this consent relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the provision of s.18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2. The walls of the extension shall be rendered and painted in a colour to match the existing property.

Reason: To preserve the character and appearance of this Listed Building.

3. The windows and doors to the extension hereby permitted shall be white painted timber.

Reason: To preserve the character and appearance of this Listed Building.

4. The roof of the extension shall be in long straw to match the existing roof of the property and the valleys at the junction of the new roof and the original roof shall be in reed straw.

Reason: In order to provide some protection to the old roof at the junction.

 The roof shall be provided with a simple block ridge with a long straw thatch.

Reason: To preserve the character and appearance of this Listed Building.

6. All materials from the demolished structure shall be removed from the site within one month of the demolition works being carried out.

Reason: To preserve and safeguard the character and appearance of this Listed Building.
