1. The work hereby authorised shall be completed within two years of the date of the decision notice.

Reason: To ensure that any change in circumstances or in the condition of the trees is taken into account.

2. Only the following works shall be carried out to the 4 Lime trees identified as T11, T12, T13 and T14 in the Tree Preservation Order Number 156:

- shorten back lateral branches extending over boundary by a maximum of 1 metre, ensuring that cuts are made at a suitable side branch or growing point, and leaving the trees with a natural shape and appearance.

This permission does not extend to cutting all branches extending over the property boundary.

Reason: To clarify the extent of the permitted works and for the avoidance of doubt.

3. All work shall be carried out in accordance with B.S.3998:1989 "Recommendations for tree work".

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.
