Proposed High Voltage Overhead Line Diversion - Cow Roast, Tring, Hertfordshire

Eastern Electricity have been informed by the Director of Technical Services, Dacorum Bornigh Council, that it is necessary to remove two staywires from a high voltage overhead line pole at Tinker's Lodge, Crawley's Lane, Wigginton, as the wires obstruct the Wigginton By-way open to all traffic Number 10.

To remove these wires it is necessary to divert the high voltage overhead line that feeds the hamlet of Cow Roast. To accomplish this our proposals are as follows:

New high voltage overheed line route A - B, two spans, supported on sigle wooden poles; this will allow removal of some six spans of overhead line at present erected between Tinker's Lodge and Cow Roast. Details all as shewn on drawing number HA3/14796/MP Issue A, subject to reasonable deviation as may be necessary, such deviation not to exceed 25m in the case of llkV overhead lines.
