**WORKS TO TREES IN THE CONSERVATION AREA
BEECHWOOD HOUSE, BEECHWOOD DRIVE, ALDBURY**

I write to inform you that the above application was considered on 10 April, 2000. The Council objects to the proposal to carry out work on the Yew tree on the following grounds:

- The work proposed would significantly alter the visual appearance of the Yew tree to the detriment of the character and amenity of the area.

Accordingly the local planning authority has decided that the Yew tree should be protected by a Tree Preservation Order. As you are most probably already aware the order has been made and took effect on 27 March, 2000.

The Council have no objections to your proposal to carry out works on the Holly tree for the following reason:

- The holly even though of character value is not worthy of protection by means of a Tree Preservation Order.
