WORKS TO TREES IN THE CONSERVATION AREA BEECHWOOD HOUSE, BEECHWOOD DRIVE, ALDBURY

I write to inform you that the above application was considered on 10 April, 2000. The Council objects to the proposal to carry out work on the Yew tree on the following grounds:
