1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The materials used externally shall match both in colour and texture those on the existing building of which this development shall form a part.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. The existing trees along the St Albans Road frontage shall be retained until the end of October 1996 (unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority) at which time they shall be removed and replaced by semi-mature specimen trees.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

4. The retained trees referred top in condition 3 shall be pruned in accordance with a Schedule of Tree Works which shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority, before any works commence on site.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

5. The semi-mature replacement specimens referred to in condition 3 shall be Tilia (Lime) and shall not be less than 50 cm diameter (measured 1 m from ground level). The position of these replacement trees shall accord with Drawing No. 950085/01 unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

6. Any replacement trees which die, are removed or become seriously damaged or diseased within five years of their planting shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of similar size and species, unless the local planning authority gives written consent to any variation to this requirement.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.
