- 1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.
- 2. The materials used externally shall match both in colour and texture those on the existing building of which this development shall form a part.
- 3. The developer shall construct the crossover to standards set out in the current edition of Hertfordshire County Council's "Specification for the Construction of Residential Estate Roads" and the development shall not be brought into use until the access is so constructed.
- 4. A 2.4 m \times 2.4 m visibility splay shall be provided each side of the access, measured from the edge of the accessway to the back of the footway, within which there shall be no obstruction to visibility between 600 mm and 2.0 m above the footway level.
- 5. Sight lines of 2.4 m x 35 m shall be provided in each direction within which there shall be no obstruction to visibility between 600 mm and 2.0 m above carriageway level.
- 6. The gradient of the driveway shall not be greater than 1 in 10.
- 7. Notwithstanding the details shown on Drawing No. A005/1, the front of the garage shall be positioned as shown on Drawing No. A00516.
