## REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00505/97/RET

Date of Decision: 29 May 1997

- 1. The application site is located within the Metropolitan Green Belt wherein there is strict control over built development. The formation of screening mounds is not identified in either the Development Plan or Department of the Environment, Planning Policy Guidance Note 2, Green Belts, as development appropriate within the Green Belt. Inappropriate development is by definition harmful to the Green Belt. The applicant has not demonstrated that very special circumstances exist in this case which are sufficient to outweigh normal policy objections.
- 2. The bund is an unnatural feature which detracts from the general character and appearance of this open Green Belt area and adversely affects the character and setting of Winkwell Conservation Area contrary to the aims of Policies 92, 107 and 110 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
