1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. There shall be no external illumination of the development hereby permitted.

Reason: To safeguard the amenity of the surrounding area.

3. The development hereby permitted shall be constructed in the materials specified on Drawing No. 669/4 or such other materials as may be agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

4. No works shall commence on the manege until full details of the surface materials shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

5. The stables and the manege hereby permitted shall not be used for any business or commercial use.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and to safeguard the rural character of the area.

6. No development shall take place until the applicant, or their agents or successors in title, has secured the implementation of a programme of archaeological work in accordance with a written scheme of investigation which has been submitted by the applicant and approved in writing by the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure that reasonable facilities are made available to record archaeological evidence.
