- 1. This consent shall extend only to the felling of T3 Common Walnut.
- 2. A replacement tree shall be planted in the first planting season following removal of the existing tree.
- 3. The replacement shall be a standard in size, ie at least 8 10 cm girth at 1 m above ground level and 2.75 to 3 m overall height.
- 4. The replacement shall be planted as close as practically possible to the site of the existing tree and shall be a Common Walnut (Junglans Regia).
- 5. The Council must be notified when the replacement tree has been planted so that an inspection can be carried out.
- 6. All works shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998 (1989) Recommendations of Tree Work.

REASONS:

1-6. The Walnut has suffered from wind blow and is now lying at an angle on the boundary fence in close proximity to a neighbouring property. Its removal is advisable on the grounds of safety.
