NOTE: This is not a separate planning permission, but must be read in conjunction with any conditions attached to the permission indicated above.

1) The pavilion shall be constructed externally using L.B.C. Capel Dark Multi-Stock bricks, dark-stained boarding, joinery and fascia, and Marley Old English Red Smooth-Faced Bold Roll roof tiles, with Marley Old English Red Smooth-Faced plain vertical tile hanging to gable ends, or such other materials as may be agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

2) Before the cricket ground is brought into use, the final layer of the car park area shall be surface-dressed with pea single or such other similar material as shall have been agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

3) The landscaping details hereby approved shall be implemented not later than the first planting season after the cricket ground is brought into use.

Reasons for Conditions 1, 2 and 3 :-

In the interests of visual amenity.

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
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
