In pursuance of their powers under the above-mentioned Acts and the Orders and Regulations for the time being in force thereunder, the Council hereby refuse the development proposed by you in your application dated 8 April 1987 and received with sufficient particulars on 13 April 1987 and shown on the plan(s) accompanying such application..

The reasons for the Council's decision to refuse permission for the development are:—

In view of the state of disrepair of the building and its status as a building of special architectural or historic interest, the local planning authority is not satisfied that, in the absence of a detailed scheme, the building is capable of conversion to form a dwellinghouse and garage which will be sympathetic to the character of the building and relate satisfactorily to the adjacent dwellinghouse and farm buildings.
