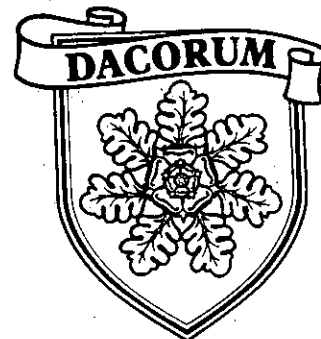

Date of Decision: 10.09.1996

During the period from 10 September 1996 up to and including 31 December 2001, retail sales from the premises shall consist only of wine produced on the site and up to a maximum of 500 75cl bottles per annum of wine produced elsewhere. On and from 1 January 2002, there shall be no retail sales from the site whatsoever other than wine produced on the site.

Reason: The application site is within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and within a rural area beyond the Green Belt, wherein general retail development is inappropriate. The temporary period is specified so that the local planning authority may retain control over the type and level of retail sales from the site, having regard to any potential or actual impact on the character and amenity of the surrounding area.
