- 1. The application site forms part of the Brook Street General Employment Area as identified in the Dacorum Borough Local Plan. These small units of industrial uses are to be retained. No evidence has been put forward to indicate that the property is unsuitable for this use, nor that there has been a detailed effort to market it for this use. Therefore the development is unacceptable in that it will deplete the amount of available employment land contrary to policies within the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
- 2. The increased use of the access which is substandard in width and visibility is likely to give rise to conditions prejudicial to highways safety.
- 3. There is inadequate provision for vehicle parking within the site to meet standards adopted by the local planning authority.
