REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00584/99/ROC

1. The site is located within the Rural Area Beyond the Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan wherein there is strict control over built development. In 1977 planning permission was granted for the erection of a detached dwelling at Marston Gate Stables. The development was contrary to established development plan policies for the area. Part of the justification for the development was the identified need for an agricultural worker's dwelling in this location. In the opinion of the local planning authority insufficient information has been submitted to demonstrate that there is no longer a continuing need for an agricultural worker's dwelling in this location. In the absence of this information the removal of the condition would be contrary to the aims and objectives of Policies 5 and 22 of the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan, Policies 5 and 25 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan 1991 – 2011 Deposit Draft and national advice contained in Planning Policy Guidance Note: 7 The Countryside – Environmental Quality and Economic and Social Development.
