

REASONS FOR REFUSAL

OF APPLICATION: 4/0588/91

1. The site is within the rural area beyond the Metropolitan Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum District Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agriculture or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. In the opinion of the local planning authority, the agricultural unit with which the proposed mobile home is to be associated is not a viable enterprise and the likelihood of its future success as an agricultural unit cannot at present be assured. The proposed development is, therefore, unacceptable in the terms of this policy.
