Conditions (continued)

- (5) The only structures which shall be brought on to the site are market stalls, toilet vans, a control van and traffic lane markers.
- (6) The market stalls shall be stripped of boards, awnings and covers at the close of each market and their boards, awnings and covers shall be removed from the site until the morning of the next market.
- (7) The only structures which may be left on the site between market days are the frames of the market stalls, which shall be stored within the area edged in red on the approved plan.
- (8) The site shall be cleared of all rubbish within two hours of the closing of each market.
- (9) No public address, amplification or broadcast system shall be used at any time in connection with the conducting of this market.
- (10) Access to the site in connection with the use hereby permitted shall not be other than at the southern end of the north-east/south-west runway.
- (11) Mobile toilet accommodation in scale with the requirements of the Council's Chief Environmental Health Officer, shall be available in the market area whenever the market is operating.

Reasons (continued)

- (4) In order to control the scale of the market and to leave adequate offstreet accommodation for car parking.
- to (7) In order to minimise the visual impact of the market in this unscreened location in Green Belt countryside.
 - (8) In the interests of amenity.
 - (9) In order to protect the amenities of nearby residents.
 - (10) In the interests of highway safety.
 - (11) In order to compensate for the absence of such facilities in the vicinity.
