Only the following works shall be carried out, and these are to be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998 (1989) Recommendations for tree work:

- (a) Tree No. T1. Horse Chestnut: remove any deadwood, snags and any weak or crossing branches as necessary; reduce crown by a maximum of 3 m whilst maintaining a natural appearance. All pruning cuts should be located at a suitable branch junction; thin by a maximum of 20%.
- (b) Tree No. T2. Oak: shorten overlong lateral branches by a maximum of 3 m: remove deadwood, snags and any weak or crossing branches as necessary; thin by a maximum of 20%.
- (c) Tree No. T3. Field Maple Tree No. T4. Oak Tree No. Gla Oak Tree No. Glb Oak

All works to these trees as for Tree No. T2.

REASONS:

- (a) Tree No. T1: this tree has suffered extensive root severance, and pruning should reduce weight, and therefore, the possibility of windblow.
- (b) Trees Nos. T2, T3, T4 and G1b: these trees have varying amounts of deadwood and superfluous branches, the removal of which will improve the health of the trees. The reduction of overlong laterals will reduce excessive weight on the branches. Pruning will improve the appearance of these trees.
- (c) Tree No. Gla: this tree appears to be declining in health and has extensive deadwood. Pruning should alleviate any danger from the deadwood and improve the appearance of the tree.
