1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The materials to be used in the construction of the external surfaces of the extension hereby permitted shall match in size, colour and texture those used on the existing building.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development.

- 3: Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (or any Order revoking or re-enacting that Order) (with or without modification):
- (a) no windows, dormer windows, doors or other openings other than those expressly authorised by this permission shall be constructed;
- (b) the garage shown on Drawing Nos. GEN 280 (PC) 001 and GEN 280 (PC) 002 rev. E shall be kept available at all times for the parking of vehicles associated with the residential occupation of the extended dwellinghouse and it shall not be converted or adapted to form living accommodation;
- (c) no garages shall be erected within the curtilage of the dwellinghouse.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of the residential amenities of the occupants of the adjacent dwellings and of controlling further development in the Green Belt in accordance with national and local planning policies.
