Your application for consent to carry out works to preserved trees dated 8 April 1999 and received on 12 April 1999 has been **GRANTED**, subject to any conditions set out overleaf.

1. The work shall be completed within two years of the date of this decision notice.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure that any change in circumstances, or in the condition of the trees, is taken into account.

2. This consent only relates to the lifting of the crowns of the two cherry trees referred to as "3" and "4" in the letter from Mrs S Gouch dated 8 April 1999 and received by the local planning authority on 12 April 1999.

<u>Reason</u>: Cherry tree "1" is not subject to a Tree Preservation Order and Ash tree "2" and Hawthorn tree "5" are dying and should be removed.

3. All work shall be carried out in accordance with B.S. 3998:1989 "Recommendations for tree work".

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.

- 4. The Ash tree shall be replaced by one of the following:
 - (a) Sorbus aria (Whitebeam);
 - (b) Prunus padus (Bird Cherry);
 - (c) Malus tschonoski (Pillar Apple).

Reason: In the interests of visual amenity.

INFORMATIVE:

It is strongly recommended that the Ash tree is removed immediately for safety reasons. The Landscape Services Unit in the Department of Environmental Services (201442 228375) can provide advice.
