

- 1. The proposed change of use would be detrimental to the amenity of nearby residential properties by reason of noise and disturbance from increased traffic movements.
- Access to the proposed development is inadequate and unsuitable for the additional traffic which would be generated.
- The proposal would have a seriously detrimental effect on the general character and amenity of a designated Conservation Area.
- 4. In the opinion of the local planning authority, the previously permitted conversion of these buildings to residential use is more appropriate than that now proposed.
