REASONS:

- 1. The proposed rear dormer windows will fall within the limits permitted under Class A of Part 1, Schedule 2 to Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988.
- 2. The proposed insertion of a new window on the flank elevation does not, in the opinion of the local planning authority, materially affect the external appearance of the property and is therefore not development within the terms of S.55(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
- 3. The proposed insertion of a roof light within the roof slope fronting Egerton Road, as long as it is flush fitting, does not in the opinion of the local planning authority, materially affect the external appearance of the property and is therefore not development within the terms of S.55(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
