REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/00677/97/FUL

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- 1. The site is within the Metropolitan Green Belt, wherein there is a presumption against inappropriate development, and within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, wherein both development and communications will be subordinated to the preservation of the beauty of the Area. The Area is not to be regarded as one of availability for development and permission will only be granted for new masts if it is satisfactorily demonstrated that a suitable alternative site either outside the Area or having a less harmful visual impact is not available. The current proposal is incompatible with these policies as it has not been satisfactorily demonstrated that such an alternative site is not available, or, alternatively, that there are difficulties which prevent the sharing of existing facilities.
- 2. Notwithstanding any technical argument as to the need for a mast in this location, greater weight should be placed on the need to protect the quality of the landscape in the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Neither additional landscaping nor painting of the mast will mitigate the damaging effects of this proposal.
