REASONS FOR REFUSAL
OF APPLICATION: 4/0704/96

- 1. The site is within a rural area beyond the Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan wherein permission will only normally be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agriculture, forestry, mineral extraction, countryside recreation uses and social, community, leisure and utility services which meet a particular proven need of the local rural community. The use of this site for retail purposes is contrary to this policy, being an inappropriate use in the rural area.
- 2. The site occupies an out-of-centre location contrary to policies in the Dacorum Borough Local Plan and national policy guidance (PPG6) which indicate that out-of-centre retail locations will only be acceptable where the proposed facility cannot be provided in a town centre or edge-of-centre location. There is no evidence that there are no more appropriate locations available elsewhere within the terms of these policies.
- 3. The proposal results in the loss of 0.7 ha of land from employment generating use. This conflicts with the employment policies of the Development Plan which aim to ensure the provision of an adequate and varied range of land and sites for employment generating activities.
- 4. The proposal would lead to a substantial increase in the movements and usage of the access at this busy trunk road located to the detriment of the safety and free flow of trunk road traffic.
